To continue updating the center, to stay competitive with the job market costs and staff wages, and because of inflation, we have decided that we will need to increase tuition this year. The new rates are as follows:

Infants 6 weeks-18 months \$229
Toddlers 18 Months-3 Years \$209
Preschool 3 years until their first-day kindergarten \$199
School-age summer rate \$169
Before and aftercare \$139
After \$99
Per day \$39
Your new contracts are attached to your timecard; please sign and return them. The new rates are effective May $30^{\text {th }}$. If you have any questions, please let me know. We try to keep our fees competitive and at the lowest possible rate while compensating our teachers at a competitive wage and providing a quality education for the children. We do realize the impact of childcare on your family's budget, so that is why it is our goal to provide the best value for your money. This is just a reminder that State Subsidy has increased its income guidelines, and we also participate in the Lincoln Littles Tuition Assistance program. If you are interested in applying to see if you qualify, you can go to https://dhhs.ne.gov/pages/accessnebraska.aspx for state subsidy.
If you are a family of four and make less than $\$ 53,000$ annually, you may be eligible to participate in the Lincoln Littles Program. Please let me know if you would like an application for the 2022/2023 year.
